mixed records of goodness or badness together will have their actions weighed and if their goodness outweighs their evils they will get returns. There is room for intercession but it will not be for those who have rebelled against the authorities set up by Allah the Apostle and Holy Imams.

Imam Ali (A.S.)in Nahjul Balagha spoke eloquently about death. He has warned us to be prepared for it and counselled us to adopt piety:"which is the strongest tie between man and Allah (swt)". He asked his Shias to be "prepared to face death with the help of your good deeds". Echoing the Holy Quran, he reiterated that each one of us has to pass between our day of Death and the day of Qiyamat In Qutba 67 he said," There is no barrier between you and heaven or hell but that of death which everyone will have to cross ".Between these two is the dark and narrow grave, the sufferings of the Barzakh ,the total disconnection of those who we love and who love us and the helplessness of our condition in the grave.

Every human soul will be questioned about its faith and deeds and will be admitted to the transitory state of Barzakh ,according to the degree of success in the response to the questioning .Before the Final judgement, deeds for the expiation of sins for the dead are still accepted through Allah's mercy. Acts of charity that still benefit others left behind, prayers and fasts completed for the marhoom by the heirs and any

sawabe jaariya like pious offspring,books of knowledge, sadqa etc. Therefore, it is incumbent upon us to have Death before our eyes and endeavour to adopt peity and humility in our life.

It is recommended by our Imams that we remember our dead and adopt piety with sincerity. The Holy Imam have repeatedly emphasized that we recall the events of Karbala and the sufferings of Imam Hussain (A.S.)when we mourn a loved one.

Duas to be recited when visiting a graveyard

A tradition from our generous seventh Imam Musa -e-Kazim (A.S.)states that "if it is not possible to go for the Ziyarat of the Imam then visit the graves of pious momineen to receive the same benefits"

When our sixth Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq (A.S.) was asked whether we should visit the graves of our momineen, he said "without doubt" The momineen are aware of our visit to their graves and they feel happy. The Imam then said that we should recite the following when visiting graveyards.

O Allah, spread out the earth beside them ,make the station of their souls achieve a higher status, and bestow your Riza to them and give them mercy through which their loneliness is relieved and their fear is changed to comfort for you have power over all things.

It is better to visit the graveyard early in the morning and makruh to go at night. Thursdays are recommended. We should give sadqa in the names of our marhoomeen, so that their rooh get the sawab.

Reciting the Holy Quraan, especially the Sura -e-Yaseen lessens the azaab for all those buried in the graveyard. Sawaab equal to the number of momineen buried there is bestowed by Allah's generosity.

Imam Raza (A.S.)recommends that when you visit a momin's grave place your hand on it , facing the Qibla and recite Sura -e- Qadr seven times.







In the final words of this Qutba, Maula says: "Verily death in a battle field in the cause of Allah (swt) is martyrdom, but for a man who truly and sincerely believes in Allah (swt) and his faith in the Holy Prophet (A.S.) and his Ahle Bait(A.S.), a death in his house and in his bed is also martyrdom. He will receive the reward of a martyr".
