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Introduction

Forty Duas

Dua means praying to Allah, who says in the Holy Quran, "ud uni astajib lakum" (40:60). Pray unto Me and I will hear your prayer. Dua is a call, a request, a supplication to the Almighty Lord. In another verse Allah says in the Quran, "And when my servants ask you concerning Me, then surely I am very near; I answer the prayer...(2:186).

Our holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW) and the Imams (AS) have taught us to never get tired of Dua. We must use this blessing to ask Allah for our needs and desires. We should seek Allah's help and we will be rewarded out of His abundant Mercy and Grace.

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The Holy Prophet Muhammad SAW said, "Dua is the weapon of the believer." It is a great tool given by Allah to believers that they can use to achieve great things and overcome problems. We should never lose hope and pray to Allah constantly. It will bring us closer to the Almighty who loves those who ask from Him. When we place our trust in Him, we will have peace of mind. Dua can change our destiny as He is in complete control. Nothing is dearer to Allah than asking Him for his blessings. We must rely on Allah's mercy. Dua can solve all our problems.

What is Dua?

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Dua is the foundation of faith to connect us to Allah. Dua is calling Allah, bringing us closer to the Almighty. It guides us to remember Allah. We address Allah directly and can talk to Allah from our heart. He is near us all the time. Allah says, "We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (50:16) By calling Him we are assured of Him looking towards us. He says in the Quran "I answer the supplicant's call when he calls Me. So let them have faith in Me." (2:186)

Dua takes us closer to Allah. When we do dua we must not merely recite the dua but realise that we are before Allah, who is our Master and Lord. Allah is all Powerful. He is the Creator and the most Beneficent and the Most Merciful.

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Standing before Him, we must be humble and realise that everything belongs to Him. Whatever we possess is from Him. We are the slave, abd, and He is the Master. We are the created and He is the Creator. Bowing down before Him, we should plead for His help. We should implore Him with tears in our eyes. He is Almighty and His Divine Mercy is always flowing.

The Quran contains many duas that the Prophets have used to supplicate Allah. The Holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW) and his Ahlulbayt (AS) have taught us many sublime prayers and guided us how to approach and ask for Divine Mercy.

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When we look at the fourteen Masoomeen, we find that each of them have guided us to seek help from Allah through dua.

The Holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW) said: "Dua is the pillar of religion and the light of the heavens and earth. It is the core of worship."

Bibi Fatima (AS) devoted herself to Allah and resorted to Him totally in all of her affairs.

Our first Imam Ali (AS) said, "The most beloved action on this earth with Allah, Mighty and Exalted, is Dua."

Imam Hasan (AS) said, "Allah has never opened the door of request only to hold back the door of response."

Imam Husayn (AS) said, "The Prophet used to raise his hands and

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implore and beg Allah, like a man begging for food.”

Imam Zainulabideen (AS) told his followers that Dua repels calamities. When we place all our needs only in Allah's hands, He will grant our every need.

Imam Muhammad Baqir (AS) said “Allah loves nothing better than that His servants ask from Him.

Our sixth Imam Jafar Sadiq (AS) called Dua a cure for every sickness.”

Imam Musa Kazim (AS) said “If you have a need from Allah then say 'O Allah verily I ask you for the sake of Muhammad and Ali for verily they have a special station with you.”

Our eighth Imam Ali Ridha (AS) urged his followers to use Dua, “the

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weapon of the Prophets” to fulfil their needs.

Imam Muhammad Taqui (AS) said, Anyone who trusts in Allah, the Almighty will please him.

Imam Ali Naqui (AS) advised: There are definite places in which Allah likes the servant to supplicate to him. One of these places is the tomb of al Husayn (AS) the Master of the Martyrs.”

Our eleventh Imam Hasan Askari (AS) advised spending the night in worship: “Reaching Allah the Almighty is a journey that is not achieved except by riding at night.”

The Master of our Age, Imam Mehdi (AS) has given us priceless trusts in the shape of duas: “O Allah, bless Muhammad and his progeny and through them place me among those who are successful

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near you in this world and the Hereafter.

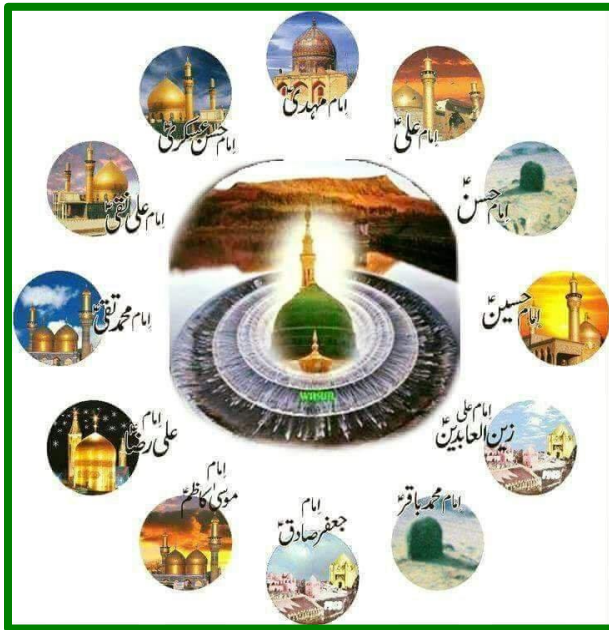

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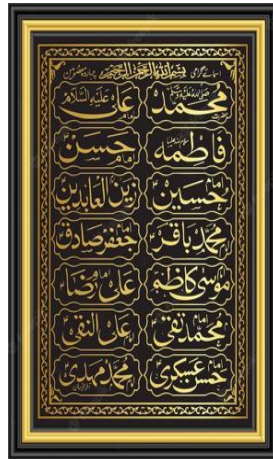

Areeza for
Imam Zamana

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An areeza is a dua in written form. We approach Imam Mehdi, the Imam of our Time, the Master of the Age and request him to grant our needs. Allah has given him the power to solve our problems. The Imam is aware of our condition and we can ask him to intercede on our behalf. The Imam knows all languages and you can write to him in any language, as often as you need. He is always ready to help us. The special time most people write to Imam Zamana is on the 15th night of Shaban, his birthday.

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We can begin the letter to Imam Mehdi (AS) like this:

Bismillahir Rahmanir Raheem

O my Master I am seeking a favour from you. I ask Allah to bestow His mercy and blessings on you. I am helpless and knowing your status you have with Allah I approach you to solve my problems. O my Master and Imam present my needs to Allah and solve my difficulties. Grant me victory and success in finding the solution to my problems. I

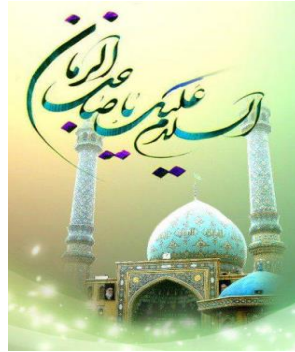

Recite 66 times for acceptance of dua. Allah is the name of the Almighty that belongs solely to Him. It combines all His Attributes. Allah is One and Only.

Al Rahman

Recite 299 times to remove forgetfulness Al Rahman reminds us of His boundless

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mercy. Al Rahman is specific to Allah.

Al Raheem

Recite 258 times in sajda for worries to disappear.

Raheem describes His special kindness and blessings for the faithful in the Hereafter.

As Salaam

Recite 131 times for cure of the sick. Salam means Peace. The abode of Peace is Paradise.

Al Wahhaab

Recite 14 times in sajda for countless blessings. He bestows favours and gifts.

Al Fattah

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Recite 70 times after Fajr for removal of doubts Al Fattah is the One who opens everything and who has the keys.

Al Samee

Recite 180 times to fulfill desires. He hears and responds to the pleas of His creation.

Al Baseer

Recite 5 times daily to cure eye problems and improve eyesight. Allah can see everything. He is with us everywhere and sees whatever we do.

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Al Adl

Recite 105 times to get Allah's help for correct decisions. He enjoins justice and Adl means putting everything in its right place. He grants everyone what is due to him.

Al Aliyy

Recite 110 times for increasing your status and rank. Al Aliyy means the Most High, sublime. He is the One above whose status there is none at all.

Al Wadood

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Recite 20 times over food and share to create love and understanding Allah is the Loving, because He loves His servants and they love Him. He is the Loving and the Beloved.

Al Waliyy

Recite 46 times on a Friday-night to overcome problems. Allah is the Waliyy, the Guardian of those who believe, in this life and the Hereafter.

Al Hayy Al Qayyoom

Recite $18+156=174$ times daily to remove distress

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Al Hayy means the Ever-Living, who is Self-sustaining and never dies. He is the Absolute Living One. Al Qayyoom is the Ever Lasting Eternal One.

Al Samad Recite 134 times to enable living without need of other's support. He on whom all depend is called Samad. He is the Master. All pleas are directed to Him.

Al Raof

Recite 286 times to make even harsh people become kind loving. He has intense

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mercy and does not stop being kind.

Al Noor Recite 256 times after salat to enlighten the heart and mind. Allah is the Light of the Heavens and earth. Noor is light. He as the Light has illuminated our hearts to know what is right.

Al Hadi

Recite 20 times daily for knowledge and wisdom. Allah is the Guide and Helper so we dua can be closer to Him. He guides the hearts to wisdom and
